3 to 6 PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Your child has the opportunity to participate in the **2023 NSW Premier's Reading Challenge** (PRC) which is presented by the Department of Education.

The Challenge aims to encourage a love of reading for leisure and pleasure in students, and to enable them to experience quality literature. It is not a competition but a challenge to each student to read, to read more and to read more widely.

Students who would like to undertake the challenge will need to read the required number of PRC books throughout terms 1, 2 and 3 (see table below).

Students who successfully complete the challenge will receive a PRC certificate in term 4.

Grades	Total number of books to be read	Min. number of PRC books to be read	Max. number of personal choice books	PRC Booklist selection
3-4	20	15	5	3-4, 5-6 & 7-9
5-6	20	15	5	5-6 & 7-9

PRC runs from **27 February to 18 August 2023**.

Mrs De Horta will be explaining to all students how they can successfully complete the challenge and how to record their books read either online (Premier's Reading Challenge website) or using a Personal Reading Log.

Students who complete the Challenge for four years receive a gold certificate, whilst those who complete it seven years receive a platinum award.
