

At Middleton Grange we ask all families to support the school and its programs, including in the following ways: wearing of school uniform; attending sporting programs, excursions and incursions when available; participating in special events and contributing to fundraising initiatives.

At Middleton Grange Public School we minimise where possible our requests for monetary and stationary contributions.

Please note, that where financial hardship is being experienced at any time, families may be eligible for assistance. Privacy is maintained. *Just make an appointment through the front office with the Principal or Deputy Principal to confidentially discuss any financial difficulties.*

#### **Excursion and Incursion**

To support and complement specific units of learning, each class may have an excursion (external to the school) and incursion (within school grounds). The amounts requested will cover transport, entry and/or activity costs.

### **Sports**

All students are strongly encouraged to participate in annual Carnivals in addition to weekly fitness, sport and physical education experiences. Please note: sport and physical education is a compulsory part of the NSW Primary Curriculum.

The amounts requested will cover transport, equipment and/or program and qualified instructor costs.

## **Other Events**

To support your child's development in a range of academic, Library, sporting, camp, cultural, Year 6, and arts areas. You will receive a note of detailed information and associated costs as these programs or events occur throughout the year.

Any program or event will require signed parental permission in addition to full payment at the time of the program or event.

Payment CANNOT be made on the day of the program or event, or after the closing due date.

Students who have not made full payment by the advertised due date, will not be able to attend or participate.
